



### GFS report of the murder of the vagrant

February 28, 1941, another vagrant was found on the grounds, also beaten to death, in the same manner. Is there more to these murders than meet the eye? New investigations proved fruitless.

*Addendum by Aleto, August 1951*

It just recently struck me that a vagrant was murdered on the university grounds ten years ago of that didn't have a resolution. There was a new murder on university grounds on the same date this year. Could this be what Ernst Gennat in 1930 describes as a "Serienmörder," i.e. a person who commits several murders? But why now, ten years apart? It needs to be investigated further, and since the police fell short, it is up to us.

*New addendum by Aleto, September 1961:*

Despite our best efforts, another vagrant was killed this year, once again on February 28<sup>th</sup>. This marks the fourth unsolved murder of its kind, each spaced exactly a decade apart. No perpetrator was found this year either. When looking into historical records, we found one case that stood out: the murder of Elijah Walker in 1921, a black man whose death was never solved. While it's too early to draw definitive conclusions, the pattern is troubling. Could we be looking at a long-term "Serienmörder"? Or is something else at play?

*Yet another addendum by Aleto, March 1971:*

We patrolled the grounds on February 28<sup>th</sup> this year, and managed to intervene before anything fatal occurred. A lone man, disoriented and afraid, was found at the exact site of the last murder. Was he to be the next victim? Some among us believe Elijah Walker's spirit may be seeking vengeance. If so, perhaps our vigilance offers some protection.

*Addendum by Anubis, March 1981*

Interesting enough, there were no attempts of murder this year. What does that mean? We will still make a note to future FRs to keep watch in 1991.
